It was noted that Win Miller is a board member of Security State Bank of Marine. After discussion, Linda moved, seconded by Pete, to accept the note of indebtedness from the Nancy B. Miller Trust in the amount of \$50,000 and seek a loan through the Security State Bank of Marine or other financial institution in the amount of \$100,000 and to use said money to purchase two new buses in the amount not to exceed \$150,000.00.
